mypharmacyonline.ca is a locally based and operated online pharmacy that gives back to non profit organizations and schools and has partnered with the Victoria German School.

Treasurer Needed

As mentioned above, our treasurer Tanja Weber-Hemerling will be leaving the Board at the end of the school year. Duties include: **Bank account maintenance:** depositing tuition income and signing checks. **Expense management:** collecting completed forms, verifying amounts and totals, issuing cheques. **Financial transaction oversight:** Being knowledgeable about who has access to the organization's funds, and any outstanding bills or debts owed, as well as developing systems for keeping cash flow manageable. **Budgets:** Developing the annual budget (with the board) as well as comparing the actual revenues and expenses incurred against the budget. **Reports:** Keeping the board regularly informed of key financial events, trends, concerns, and assessment of fiscal health in addition to completing required financial reporting forms in a timely fashion and making these forms available to the board.

Works cooperatively with the bookkeeper; participates in board meetings and acts as backup payroll administrator as required.
