Jobs and Volunteer positions @ VGS

Administrative Assistant Needed (paid part time position)

Duties

- Administer registration process and follow up with prospective students
- Collect and administer tuition payments in collaboration with VGS treasurer
- Keep data about payments up to date
- Respond to inquiries regarding tuition/payments/etc. from VGS families and external parties via email, phone or in person
- Processing payment of teachers' salaries
- Be available on Saturdays (9-13h) and Tuesdays (15.30-18.30) at UVIC in order to respond personally to parent requests and queries.
- Handle petty cash box and teacher's claim forms in cooperation with the treasurer
- General administrative duties required

Qualifications

- Strong verbal and written English communication skills
- Spoken and written skills in German would be an asset
- Must work independently with minimal instructions
- Excellent computer skills, including Excel
- Experience with planning and organizing events

Treasurer Needed (volunteer position)

Our treasurer Tanja Weber-Hemerling will be leaving the Board at the end of the school year. If you feel that you would like to volunteer your skills in this capacity, please contact Ralf (info@victoriagermanschool.org).

Duties include:

- Bank account maintenance: depositing tuition income and signing checks.
- Expense management: collecting completed forms, verifying amounts and totals, issuing cheques.
- Financial transaction oversight: Being knowledgeable about who has access to the organization's funds, and any outstanding bills or debts owed, as well as developing systems for keeping cash flow manageable.
- Budgets: Developing the annual budget (with the board) as well as comparing the actual revenues and expenses incurred against the budget.
- Reports: Keeping the board regularly informed of key financial events, trends, concerns, and assessment of fiscal health in addition to completing required financial reporting forms in a timely fashion and making these forms available to the board.

The treasurer works cooperatively with the bookkeeper and the admin assistant; participates in board meetings and acts as backup payroll administrator as required.

Library Helper (volunteer position)

We are looking for a volunteer who is willing to help once a week during school times with the organisation of our mobile library.

Duties include:

- Organising the library by age / skill level
- Tagging new books
- Picking up book donations
