Registration will start in August. The classes VGS will be offering are:

Beginner 1 German – Adult

No prior knowledge of German is required. Beginner 1 introduces the German language. Learn the basics of pronunciation and grammar with variety of classroom activities covering reading, speaking, writing and listening. The pace of the class is suited to all abilities.

Wednesday 4:00 to 5:30pm Oct 7-Dec 16

Beginner 2 German – Adult

The class continues on where Beginner left off. Some basic German ability is needed to join this class.

Wednesday 5:30 to 7:00pm Oct 7-Dec 16

German Kids Club

Kid's Club will be entirely in German. The course is activity focused. There will be a variety of classroom activities from puppetry to arts and crafts. The pace of the class is suited to all abilities.

WE welcome and encourage members to help with the set up and take down of Kaffee und Kuchen.


Calling for New Board Members



FALL Adult Classes at UVic

The University of Victoria has been chosen, as one of a select few post-secondary institutions in North America (and the only one in Canada), to receive a fully funded DAAD instructor. Each year UVIC will host an instructor from Germany. Our first DAAD instructor, Anja Rockel, will be teaching for us during the 2015-2016 academic year and will be offering two lower-level German language courses and two upper-level courses.

Both classes are geared for advanced German language students. UVIC is excited and grateful to have been chosen by the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) to receive a DAAD instructor.

A CHANGE IN TIME for some of the Tuesday classes

Due to renovations in various parts of UVic, the Clearihue Bldg has not as many rooms available to us at the times we would like. From September to December there are 3 classes that will start later. They are the A2, DSD1 and DSD2 classes. The classrooms will also be located on a different floor and in a different wing, but remain in the Clearihue Bldg. Fortunately, we will be back to our regular schedule starting in January 2016. We are sorry for any inconvenience this may cause and we will be contacting the students and their families with more details shortly.

THE IMPORTANCE of continuity from year to year

Learning a language does take a long time. Students cannot begin a language in high school and be expected to use it for real-life purposes any more than they can be expected



to take two years of beginning mathematics and be prepared to be engineers. But time is not the only important factor. Student engagement is also very important. Students need to carry out meaningful & purpose driven tasks that allow them to use language as a tool. Being motivated to understanding others and communicating their own ideas is the key. The importance of conversing in German with parents, grandparents, relatives and peers cannot be over-emphasized. Such interaction provides students with

opportunities to gain cultural understanding and skills in knowing how and what to say to whom. The family support surrounding the child is just as important as coming to class.


